RE: BATTING RANGE SAFETY UPDATE
FALL '92 TRADE SHOW SCHEDULE

Dear Batting Range Owners,

SAFETY IN THE BATTING CAGES

In keeping with our continuing effort to assure SAFETY IN THE BATTING CAGES we wanted to again stress the need for FACE GUARDS ON THE BATTING HELMETS. Many of you use these safety masks. All of our new owners are provided these masks with the original equipment package. Those of you that do not currently use these masks should IMMEDIATELY ATTACH THESE MASKS ON TO YOUR EXISTING HELMETS. We have these masks in stock for immediate shipment or they may be purchased at any local "team" sporting goods dealer. Call us if you have any questions about these masks.

Some of our owners have an AGE or HEIGHT LIMIT for the use of the batting cages. We strongly urge that all of our owners sufficiently monitor the use of the FASTER baseball cages and/or softball cages. You may want an AGE or HEIGHT LIMIT to avoid younger players from being injured in cages which they are "under-skilled" to use. We are not aware of any standard in the industry for these limits. We suggest that you use your best judgement when establishing these standards. (An example may be 8 years or older for slower baseball and softball and 12 years old for the faster baseball and softball cages. Children being supervised by their parents or guardians should also be stressed) SUFFICIENT MONITORING OF THE CAGES IS IMPERATIVE TO ASSURE COMPLIANCE OF THESE LIMITS AND ASSURE SAFETY FOR ALL OF YOUR USERS. WARNING SIGNS ARE NOT ENOUGH! WELL-TRAINED ATTENDANTS MUST BE USED AT ALL TIMES TO MONITOR THE USE OF THE CAGES!


